Lazy Days by Brian Chapple

What does the title mean?

It's a descriptive title. Lazy = slouching around - you can hear this in the rhythm of the music.

What key is this in?

G major

Any key changes?

Slight key change around bars 9 to 12 (sounds like C major). Lots of chromatic notes used because this is in a blues style.

Notation:

Commodo - comfortably (at a comfortable speed)

4/4 - simple quadruple time (time signature) - 4 crotchet beats per bar

Staccato - short and detatched

tie - tie the value of the notes together

slur - play legato

natural - cancels the sharp or flat

> = accent - accent the note by stressing it louder than the others

_ = tenuto - soft accent

ad. lib - at your own freedom

fermata - pause - hold the note longer than written

8va - play the notes one octave higher than written

pedal mark - hold the damper pedal down triplet - three notes in the time of two
