Sonatina Op 36 No 1 3rd Movement by Clementi

What does the title mean?

Sonatina is a little sonata. Sonata is a word that means piece for instrument/s (opposite to cantata which means piece for voice). Op 36 - op = opus - work number. No 1 - number 1. 3rd movement - a sonatina usually has 3 movements.

What key is this in?

This is in C major.

Are there any key changes?

Yes - in bar 25, it goes to G major. Then in bar 31 back to C major.

Notation:

Vivace - lively/fast legato - smooth and well-connected 3/8 - time signature - simple triple - 3 quavers in a bar dim. - diminuendo - gradually getting softer cres. - crescendo - gradually getting louder staccato - short and detatched slurs - play legato quaver rest - rest for a beat
