

(List A) *Frollicky Rollicky Wind* by Coburn

**What does the title mean?**

The music is a picture of a witch riding on her broomstick through the wind and the title is about this wind called Frollicky Rollicky Wind who the witch casts a spell on. The music tells this story.

**What key is this in?**

A minor

(Possible key change in bars 23 to 31, E major, dominant of A minor)

**Notation:**

Molto allegro – much fast and lively

Metronome marking – 160 crotchets per minute

Lento – slow

Metronome marking – 96 crotchets per minute

Allegro – fast and lively

Metronome marking – 88 dotted crotchets per minute

A tempo – return to original speed

2/4 – time signature – 2 crotchet beats per bar (simple duple)

6/8 – time signature – 6 quaver pulses per bar (2 dotted crotchet beats per bar) (compound duple)

Sharp sign – raise the note by a semitone

Natural sign – cancels the sharp or flat

mp – mezzo piano = moderately soft

p – piano = soft

cresc. – crescendo = gradually getting louder

mf – mezzo forte = moderately loud

f – forte = loud

dim. – diminuendo = gradually getting softer

sf – sforzando – sudden accent

rall. – rallentando = gradually getting slower

fermata – pause sign = hold the note for longer than its value

staccato – short and detached

slurs – legato – smooth and well connected

tenuto – hold for full length (soft accent)

tie – tie the notes together (combine the note values)

acciaccatura – quick note before the main note (to crush)

accent sign – emphasise the note

pedal sign – for the damper pedal – sustain the note (down and up)

glissando – rapid scale over the keys

8va – ottava – 8 notes higher than written

morendo – dying away (softer)

Need to know note names (pitch) and note values (rhythm) including rests.
