time signature - 4/4 - simple quadruple - 4 beats per bar mf - mezzo forte - moderately crescendo (cresc.) - gradually getting louder metronome marking - 100 crotchets per minute staccato - short and detatched accent > - marcato - emphasise the note by playing it louder tenuto _ - stress the notes by holding it for its full value flat - lower the note by a semitone sharp - raise the note by a semitone natural - cancel the sharp or flat f - forte - loud
