What does the title mean?

The title is an image of a garden with no one in it. The minor key and sad melody suits the image.

What key is this in?

E minor

Notation:

Andante - a little walking pace

Metronome marking - around 80 minims per minute

Espressivo - play expressively

LH legato - play the left hand smoothly and well-connected

Mf - mezzo forte - moderately loud

4/4 - time signature - 4 crotchet beats per bar

Slur - play legato

Mp - mezzo piano - moderately soft

Sharp - raise the note a semiton

Cresc. - crescendo - gradually getting louder

Rit. - ritardando - gradually getting slower

A tempo - return to original speed

Diminuendo - gradually getting softer

First and second time ending

Repeat - repeat the music

Double bar line - end of the piece

Also need to know all note names and rhythmical values
