Need to know pitch names, note durations, clefs, stave, barlines, key/time signatures, musical terms and signs

Pitch

Metronome marking - 120 crotchets per minute

p - piano - soft

f - forte - loud

slur - play smoothly

crescendo - gradually getting louder
