What does the title mean?

'La Candeur' is French for Sincerity. Sincerity is like being honest about something. The music sounds like sincerity because it is heartfelt. Op. = opus (work number).

What key is this in? C major Bars 7 to 8 it goes to G major Then at bar 9 it returns to C major

Notation:

Allegro moderato - moderately fast and lively Metronome marking - 152 crotchets per minute C - common time - 4/4 - 4 crotchet beats per bar Dolce - sweetly p - piano - soft Crescendo - gradually getting louder Diminuendo - gradually getting softer Slur - smoothly connect the notes Tie - hold the notes for their combined value Repeat sign - repeat the section

Repeat sign - repeat the section Sharp - raise the note a semitone mf - mezzo forte - moderately loud Flat - lower the note a semitone Natural - cancel the sharp or flat

Dolce e poco riten. - dolce e poco ritenuto - sweetly and a little immediately held back

A tempo - return to original speed

Sf - sforzando - sudden accent/loud note

f - forte - loud

pp - pianissimo - very soft
