Tartan by Elissa Milne

What does the title mean?

Tartan is a type of checked fabric from Scotland that indicates family clan. This piece has many Scottish elements, such as a melody with grace note (acciaccatura) ornaments plus drone that is reminiscent of Scottish bagpipes, and folk elements such as changing time signatures.

What key is this in?

C major. There are no key changes.

8vb - play one octave lower than written

Notation:

Reeling - like a Scottish dance
Mf - mezzo forte - moderately loud
Diminuendo - gradually getting softer
Staccato - short and detached
Slur - play legato
Mp - mezzo piano - moderately soft
Subito - suddenly
F - forte - loud
Crescendo - gradually getting louder
P - piano - soft
Acciaccatura - short quick note before the main note (type of ornament)
ff - fortissimo - very loud
Pedal - use the damper pedal
Tie - hold the notes for their combined value

^{*}Hemiola - a rhythmical device where in 6/8 time, the accent is changed to be in 3.
