What does the title mean?

Sonata means 'to sound' - a piece for instrument.

1st subject bars 1 to 12 - D major

Bridge bars 13 to 21

2nd subject bars 22 to 38 - A major

Codetta bars 38 to 51 - A major

Development bars 52 to 71

- bar 52 A minor

- bar 56 E minor

- bar 60 B minor

- bar 64 E minor

- bar 66 D minor

- bar 70 A major to return to D major

Recapitulation

1st subject bars 72 to 84 - D major

Bridge bars 85 to 92

2nd subject bars 93 to 109 - D major

Codetta bars 110 to end - D major

Period and style:

Classical - simple diatonic progressions, formal structure, ornaments, scale/arpeggio figuration, contrasting character, defined rhythm and momentum, strong cadence points, Alberti/broken chordal figuration, homophonic texture.
