Allegro moderato - moderately fast and lively Sonatine - a piece of two or three movements for instrument (sonata means to sound) snootiness is a little sonata p - piano - soft cresc - gradually get louder dim - gradually get softer staccato - short and detatched tenuto - hold the note for its full value - stress the note slur - play legato - smooth and well-connected staccato with a slur - mezzo staccato - moderately detatched f - forte - loud marcato - marked - bring out the notes Time signature - 4/4 - simple quadruple time - 4 crotchet beats per bar

Keys:

This piece begins in G major (tonic chord G major, dominant chord D major) At bar 13 the piece modulates to the relative minor E minor (tonic chord E minor, dominant chord B major)

At bar 24 the piece modulates back to G major until the end of the piece.
