What does the title mean?

The title is a pictorial one, about water going through a water mill to make the mill work. This can be heard in the rushing semiquavers and the precise LH quavers.

What key is this in?

G major

Notation:

Moderato - moderate speed

$\text{♩} = 92-96$  Metronome marking - crotchet = 92-96

2/4 - simple duple time - 2 crotchet beats per bar

$f$  f - forte - loud

$\text{staccato}$  Staccato - short and detached

$\text{slur}$  Slur - play legato - smoothly connected

$\text{accent}$  Accent - play the note louder

$\#$  Sharp - raise the note a semi tone

$p$  P - piano - soft

$\text{crescendo}$  Crescendo - gradually getting louder

$\text{repeat}$  Repeat mark - repeat the section

$\text{ritard.}$  Ritard. - ritardando - gradually getting slower

$\text{diminuendo}$  Diminuendo - gradually getting softer

$\text{fermata}$  Fermata - pause - hold longer than written

$\text{pedal}$  Pedal marking - use the damper pedal

$\text{double bar line}$  Double bar line - the end
